## Conflict Minerals Declaration

are committed to supporting the global effort to end violence, human rights violations, and environmental harm. As part of this commitment, we prioritize sourcing products from manufacturers that share our values. Since we exclusively collaborate with reputable, recognized, and established manufacturers, we expect full compliance with these principles from our supply chain partners.

On August 22, 2012, the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) implemented the final Conflict Minerals Rule under [Section 1502 the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act](#). This regulation requires publicly traded companies to annually report the use of conflict minerals (tin, tungsten, tantalum, and gold, collectively known as "3TG") originating from the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or neighboring countries.

As this rule primarily applies to U.S. publicly traded companies, and the majority of our customers and suppliers are based in Europe, BIBUS BV, as a respected trading company, is not obligated to maintain a database confirming the compliance of our suppliers (or their part numbers) with these guidelines. Consequently, while we take this matter seriously, we cannot guarantee complete compliance with the Conflict Minerals Rule nor accept liability for it.

Should this regulation become mandatory for our operations, BIBUS BV will require all suppliers to submit a completed conflict minerals declaration using the [EICC/GeSI Conflict Minerals Reporting Template](#).

Until such time, the above statement represents our current position on this matter.
